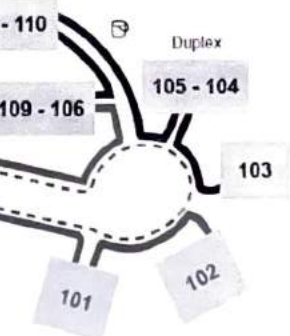

- Please sort your recyclable items in the appropriate bins outside your building
